PODIATRY PROCEDURES

- Outpatient
- Inpatient

Soft Tissue Procedure

- Excision of verrucae and nevi
- Avulsion of nail-plate-partial or complete
- Incision and drainage of superficial abscess
- Excision of foreign body mass digital and forefoot
- Tendon lengthening of metatarsal phalangeal joint
- Capsulotomy interphalangeal joint
- Excision of soft tissue tumors
- Excision of lesions of tendon sheath or capsule cyst or ganglion
- Repair of lacerations

Digital Procedures

- Arthrodesis interphalangeal joints w/ fixation
- Excision of extosis exostectomy
- Excision of tumor
- Incision and drainage
- Open reduction of digital fracture
- Phalangectomy -partial or complete
- Osteotomy of phalanx-Akin procedure with fixation
- Excision of interphalangeal sesamoid
- Correction of cocked-up 5th digit
- Excision of soft tissue tumor or mass benign

Digital Procedures

- Syndactalization
- Repair of syndactalization or desyndacatalization

Forefoot-Metatarsal & Metatarsal Phalangeal Joint

- Metatarsal head resection partial or complete
- Tailor's bunionectomy
- Closed reduction metatarsal fracture
- Excision of sesamoid bone first metatarsal phalangeal joint
- Osteotomy of lesser metatarsal-with or without internal/external fixation
- Excision of exostosis
- Osteotomy first metatarsal with or without internal/external fixation
- Incision and drainage of abscess
- Excision of accessory bones
- Excision of implant and/or fixation devices
- Correction of Hallux Varus

Bunionectomies

- Simple -silver
- Soft tissue-McBride or modified McBride
- Radical-Keller
- with osteotomy metatarsal neck
- with osteotomy metatarsal base-opening or closing
- with osteotomy proximal phalanx
- with tendon transfers
- with double wedge osteotomy first metatarsal
- with combination of above with more than one osteotomy
- Bunionectomy with implants

Rearfoot Procedures

- Incision and drainage of abscess
- Excision of soft tissue tumor or mass
- Plantar fascial release
- Exostectomy of tarsal bones
- Excision of accessory bones
- Endoscopic Plantar fascial release
- Osteotomy talar calcaneus
- Ankle Arthroscopy
- Debridement of ulcer soft tissue and/or bone
- Ray resection
- Forefoot amputations
- Tarsel tunnel decompression
- ORIF foot fractures
- Primary ankle repair or lateral stabilization
