#### **Honor Flight Continues Its Urgent Mission of Flying World War II Veterans to Visit the World War II Memorial in Washington D.C.**

*(HonorFlight.org)* The Honor Flight Network is tirelessly working to make the dreams of thousands of WWII Veterans come true, all across America. Honor Flight Network hubs are now in 31 states, over 70 different locations, with more forming every week.

Honor Flight is dedicated to providing U.S. World War II veterans the richly deserved and now urgent opportunity to personally experience the very memorial that honors their contributions to the country's history and freedom.

During the day, veterans are escorted and cared for by "guardians." Guardians are next-generation family members and/or volunteers who accompany the veterans on their trip. As schedules permit, participants visit the World War II, Korean, Vietnam and Iwo Jima Memorials. Flights, meals, tee shirts and deluxe motor coach services are provided at no cost to the World War II Veterans. The flights return later that same evening.

### ***Career Tip of the Month***

#### **10 Tips to Getting Acclimated (RNWeb.com)**

Are you a recent graduate or returning to the workforce after several years? Changing jobs, working as a traveler, or dealing with a difficult new boss? The following tips can help you hit the ground running.

##### *1. Do your homework.*

If you're new to the hospital as a staffer or traveler, make sure you have the paperwork, licensure, and necessary certification before you start. Some hospitals require certification up front, while others allow you to complete

training after your start date. For example, one facility's policy may require a med/surg nurse moving to the ED to complete ACLS training before she starts while another institution's procedures may call for staff to help her obtain certification once she is at the new unit.

## *2. Speak up.*

Whether you're switching units or starting at a new facility, ask plenty of questions at orientation to ensure that you feel confident about your surroundings. Inquiring about policies and procedures, staffing, and the role of other healthcare providers will ensure a smooth transition.
